There are no requirements for road closures throughout December, however, and to provide you with advanced notice, the A606 (South of Melton) Burton Road will be closed from 08th Jan 2024 from 06:00 to 28th January 23:59 to carry out service diversion works across the A606. Diversion routes will be clearly signposted.



Traffic from the North A46 & Nottingham heading South to Oakham/Stamford will be diverted via A46 > A52 > A1 > A606 for Stamford/Rutland and Oakham.

Traffic from the South heading North will be diverted via the A1 > A607 for Melton and A1 > A52 for Nottingham.

Traffic from Melton can use the diversion route via the A607 to the A1 to head South.

Note - A606 Nottingham Road in and out of Melton will remain open.






Summary of work progressed or completed in December 2023

Advanced Road Closure Notification A606 Nottingham Rd / St Bartholomew's way

The A606 Nottingham Road and St Bartholomew's Way will be closed from 06:00 Saturday 23rd March 2024 until 19:00 Sunday 24th March 2024, at which point we will reopen the A606 Nottingham Road. We will still be working on St Bartholomew's Way, which will

remain closed until 18:00 Thursday 28th March 2024.

Please be aware that, as a contingency measure, it may be necessary to complete any outstanding works on St Bartholomew's Way between Tuesday 2nd April 2024 and Friday 5th April.
